
Look up different Bible apps for your phone. Did you know that in the YouVersion app you can make verse images, get badges for completing reading plans, and share everything with friends?








Pick a verse you want to memorize and come up with some movements to go along with it. Then show the motions to your friend and she can try and guess what the verse says.

- 3. Can you imagine that God is confessing His love to you (yes, you!)?


Verse


- 1. Are you ashamed of your faith? What specifically?

- 3. Have you ever asked God for more courage?


Verse







